"The spices turmeric, candlenut, horseradish, mustard seed, nutmeg and chilli are commonly used in my home town of Bandung, Indonesia. Together with the human body these local ingredients are the media for this collaborative work with the public. It is a dialogue on the importance of human relations, using performance art to bridge differences in religion, ethnicity and language. Art has the power to nurture feelings, unite beliefs and attitudes as inspiration to the world to stop war. We have to unite together to insist: No more war! Nie wieder Krieg! Peace on Earth; stop the destruction of nature. Join me to inspire world peace.
