Objective List

ISA Art is proud to present "Objective List", an exhibition of Taufiq ht and Tempa, launching 30 October through 30 December 2021, at the ISA Art Incubator Gallery – Omah Budoyo, Yogyakarta. Objective List was chosen as the title of this exhibition due to the combination of narratives from Taufiq and Tempa emphasizing that items with more value than meaning are questions in their life journey and Objective List Theory. According to the Objective List Theory, people can achieve happiness if they can fulfill various desired goals such as material needs, freedom, health, education, knowledge, travel, and friendship.

In this exhibition, both Taufiq's and Tempa's works have different lines and treatments used for the media. They have the same narrative as a compositional play of objects in a house area becoming a correlation of works as an intimate medium of self-existence. Their works mark the practice of self-reflection in the surrounding environment to foster an attitude of accepting changes during a pandemic situation.

Every artist has the same sensitivity and nostalgia to the meaning of a house. They believe that there is a sense of belonging and a desire to return home, both physically and psychologically (a place of comfort, family, or even death). Taufiq and Tempa attempt to analyze, unpack, read and rearrange objects of everyday life.

The works of Tempa and Taufiq delivers a message which reminds us that objects and materials in the form of physical and non-physical are a reflection of a person's ability to achieve happiness after fulfilling various material needs. It is also a message that we can answer questions that exist and increase awareness that we as humans have a very important role in determining the destiny of this world.

It is an honor for ISA Art and Design to introduce this exhibition at our incubator gallery, Omah Budoyo, and present the work of Taufiq and Tempa.

ISA Art dengan bangga mempersembahkan "Objective List", pameran duet Taufiq.HT dan Tempa, akan diluncurkan pada 30 October hingga 30 December 2021, di Gallery Incubator ISA Art – Omah Budoyo, Yogyakarta. Objective List dipilih sebagai judul pameran ini dekarenakan perpaduan Narasi dari Tempa dan Taufiq yang menekankan pada hal-hal yang memiliki nilai lebih dan makna lebih yang menjadi pertanyaan dalam perjalanan kehidupan mereka seperti halnya Objective List Theory. Menurut objective list theory, kebahagiaan tercapai jika individu mampu memenuhi berbagai tujuan yang diinginkan misalnya pemenuhan kebutuhan materi, kebebasan, kesehatan, pendidikan, pengetahuan, perjalanan dan pertemanan.

Dalam pameran duet ini, baik karya Taufiq maupun Tempa memiliki garis dan perlakuan yang berbeda pada media berkarya. Tetapi memiliki keluasan narasi yang sama dengan permainan komposisi dari objek-objek yang berada di area rumah tersebut, menjadi sebuah korelasi karya dan merupakan media intim eksistensi diri, pada kekaryaan mereka menandai praktik refleksi diri dan keadaan sekitar untuk menumbuhkan sikap menerima perubahan situasi pandemi.

Secara gagasan, setiap seniman memiliki kepekaan yang sama terhadap makna dari sebuah rumah, Mereka percaya bahwa adanya rasa memiliki dan keinginan untuk pulang ke rumah, baik secara fisik ataupun psikis (tempat nyaman, keluarga, atau bahkan kematian). Mereka berusaha untuk menganalisis, membongka, membaca serta menyusun kembali objek-objek di keseharian.

Karya-karya Tempa dan Taufiq mengantarkan pesan dan mengingatkan akan objek dan materi yang berupa fisik dan non fisik sebagai perenungan apakah kebahagiaan mampu tercapai setelah memenuhi berbagai kebutuhan materi, ataupun kemampuan untuk menjawab segala tanya yang ada dan meningkatkan kesadaran bahwa kita sebagai manusia memiliki peran yang sangat besar dalam menentukan takdir di dunia ini. Oleh karena itu merupakan suatu kehormatan dan kesempatan berharga bagi ISA Art and Design untuk membuat pameran ini di ruang Inkubator kami dan mempresentasikan karya-karya dengan potensi terbaik mereka.

Objective List

Tempa

In this exhibition, Tempa reimagines the physical concept of objects in and around the house, where one can lie down together or alone. This forges the question of a house and objectification. "Does the house have to be physically a building with steel construction and a place for us to take shelter? Or someone we love; parents, siblings, lovers? A white sandy beach or a village where we spend our childhood or a house we can take with us everywhere? A sense of belonging and a desire to return to "home".

Taufiq ht

Silent Road became the theme and space for the contemplation of Taufiq ht's work. In Taufiq's work, he represents questions and choices regarding travel, as with the theme of Silent Road, Taufiq chose it because the road is a "place" and a verb to walk, pass, run, walk, fight, risk. According to Taufiq, "On the way, anyone must "go home" (physical home, comfortable place, family, or even death).

Tempa

Dalam pameran ini Tempa menggambarkan kembali konsep fisik sebuah rumah, benda yang ada di dalam maupun sekitar rumah, tempat kita bias berbaring, Bersama, sendiri maupun berbagi. Tempa Mempertanyakan objektifikasi dari sebuah rumah "Apakah rumah harus berbentuk fisik sebuah bangunan berkonstruksi baja dan tempat kita berteduh? Atau seseorang yang kita cinta; orang tua, saudara, kekasih? Sebuah pantai berpasir putih atau sebuah desa ketika kita menghabiskan waktu kecil atau rumah yang bisa kita bawa kemanapun? Rasa memiliki dan keinginan untuk pulang ke "rumah".

Taufiq ht

Silent Road menjadi tema dan ruang kontemplasi bagi kekaryaan Taufiq ht. Dia mempertanyakan tentang banyak hal, tentang mana yang harus diperjuangkan, di relakan. Dalam karya Taufiq merepresentasikan pertanyaan dan pilihan mengenai perjalanan, sebagamana dengan tema Silent Road sendiri Taufiq pilih karena road merupakan "tempat" sekaligus kata kerja berjalan, melewati, berlari, berjalan, memperjuangkan, mempertaruhkan. Menurut Taufiq "Dalam perjalanan siapapun juga pasti "pulang kerumah" (rumah fisik, tempat nyaman, keluarga, atau bahkan kematian).

Taufiq HT (born 1990, Mojokerto, East Java), with a background in art education in Yogyakarta, tends to explore various techniques and media as a visual language, an amalgamation of invented, artificial art, and low-quality objects then improvised, combined with imagined images that appear before and during the process of working on the work, then arranged to achieve the expected visual perfection.

Ahead of the first solo exhibition in 2021 in Bandung, the focus is on working on the plant series as a visual language representing personal and social experiences.
